8 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL  
9 SERVICES, OPERATING EXPENSES AND DATA PROCESSING  
10 SYSTEM/SERVICES FOR THE OFFICE OF THE TREASURER OF  
11 STATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2018; AND  
12 FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

15 AN ACT FOR THE OFFICE OF THE TREASURER OF  
16 STATE APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2017-2018  
17 FISCAL YEAR.

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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 *SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established*  
24 *for the Office of the Treasurer of State for the 2017-2018 fiscal year, the*  
25 *following maximum number of regular employees.*

14 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for  
 15 the Office of the Treasurer of State for the 2017-2018 fiscal year, the  
 16 following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as  
 17 "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: five  
 18 (5) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to  
 19 exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or  
 20 its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

22 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,  
 23 to the Office of the Treasurer of State, to be payable from the State Central  
 24 Services Fund, for personal services, operating expenses, data processing  
 25 system/services, *debt collection and Financial/Educational Programs including*  
 26 *the Arkansas 529 College Savings Program, Arkansas ABLE Program and financial*  
 27 *education* of the Office of the Treasurer of State for the fiscal year ending  
 28 June 30, 2018, the following:

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9           SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - INVESTMENTS - CASH. There is hereby  
 10 appropriated, to the Office of the Treasurer of State, to be payable from the  
 11 cash fund deposited in the State Treasury as determined by the Chief Fiscal  
 12 Officer of the State, for operating expenses and data systems and services  
 13 for the Investments operations of the Office of the Treasurer of State for  
 14 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, the following:

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26           SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER  
 28 PROVISION. After receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the  
 29 State, and prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget  
 30 Committee, the Treasurer of State is authorized to transfer appropriation  
 31 from any line item authorized in the Operations Appropriation of the  
 32 Treasurer's Office in this Act to any other line item authorized in the  
 33 Operations Appropriation.

34           The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2016~~  
 35 2017 through June 30, ~~2017~~ 2018.

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1 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
2 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
3 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
4 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
5 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
6 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
7 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
8 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
9 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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11 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
12 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
13 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
14 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
15 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
16 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
17 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
18 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

19  
20 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
21 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
22 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
23 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2017 is essential to the operation of  
24 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
25 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
26 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2017 could work irreparable harm  
27 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
28 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
29 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
30 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2017.
