21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

33 SECTION 24. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING
 35 TRANSFER. The Department of Career Education shall transfer from time to
 36 time as needed and at the discretion of the Director, an amount not to exceed

1 \$100,000 annually from the Skills Development Fund to the Department of
2 Career Education Fund Account to provide for the expenses and reimbursement
3 costs for non-legislative task force members of the Legislative Task Force on
4 Workforce Education Excellence as provided under § 25-16-902 and as
5 appropriated in this Act.

6 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2017~~

9 SECTION 25. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FEDERAL
11 MATCHING. The funds appropriated in Sections for Adult Basic and General
12 Adult Education, Coordinated Career Education Services, Vocational Center Aid
13 and Vocational Start-up Grants and Aid of this Act may also be used to match
14 any available federal funds from any agency in order to provide the maximum
15 amount of money possible for the purposes enumerated in such Section.

16 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2017~~
17 2018 through June 30, ~~2018~~ 2019.

18
19 SECTION 26. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
21 VOCATIONAL START-UP. The funds and appropriations contained herein for
22 Vocational Start-Up shall be allocated in accordance with rules established
23 by the Career Education and Workforce Development Board, after the rules have
24 undergone a review and approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
25 Budget Committee under § 10-3-309.

26 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2017~~
27 2018 through June 30, ~~2018~~ 2019.

28
29 SECTION 27. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
30 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ADULT
31 EDUCATION DISTRIBUTION. All funds that become available for Adult Education
32 shall be distributed to those administrative units determined to be operating
33 efficient and effective adult education programs, under criteria established
34 by the Career Education and Workforce Development Board. The criteria shall
35 include the relative efficiency of administration of the program in the
36 counties served and achievement of federal performance indicators. The Career

1 Education and Workforce Development Board shall promulgate rules and
2 regulations for the distribution of funds in accordance with criteria to be
3 determined by the Board. In the distribution of funds to local units the
4 Board shall consider performance in meeting state and federal performance
5 indicators. Unallocated funds will be redistributed based upon need as
6 determined by the Career Education and Workforce Development Board.

7 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2017~~
8 2018 through June 30, ~~2018~~ 2019.

9
10 SECTION 28. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
12 OF FUNDS – PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall
13 establish, upon request from the Department of Career Education, a special
14 appropriation line item to be used in the acquisition of promotional items.
15 When the Department of Career Education wishes to transfer monies from its
16 operating expenses appropriation to the Promotional Items line, the Career
17 Education and Workforce Development Board shall approve the request and
18 forward it after receiving prior review and approval by the Arkansas
19 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, to the Chief Fiscal Officer of
20 the State for processing.

21 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
22 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
23 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
24 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
25 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
26 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
27 has determined that the Department of Career Education may operate more
28 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Career
29 Education authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both
30 necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by
31 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
32 as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative
33 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section.
34 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
35 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction,
36 this entire section is void.

1 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2017
 2 2018 through June 30, ~~2018~~ 2019.

3
 4 SECTION 29. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
 5 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
 6 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
 7 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 8 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 9 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 10 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 11 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 12 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

13
 14 SECTION 30. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 15 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 16 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
 17 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
 18 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
 19 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
 20 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
 21 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

 23 SECTION 31. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1,
