8 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR GRANTS AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES RELATED TO CRISIS INTERVENTION FOR
10 THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES - DIVISION OF AGING,
11 ADULT AND BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES WHICH SHALL BE
12 SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS
13 APPROPRIATED BY ACT 840 OF 2017; AND FOR OTHER
14 PURPOSES.

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18 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN
19 SERVICES - DIVISION OF AGING, ADULT AND
20 BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES - COMMUNITY
21 BASED CRISIS INTERVENTION SUPPLEMENTAL
22 APPROPRIATION.

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25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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27 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - COMMUNITY BASED CRISIS INTERVENTION. There
28 is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human Services - Division of
29 Aging, Adult and Behavioral Health Services, to be payable from the
30 Behavioral Health Services Fund Account, for grants and operating expenses
31 related to crisis intervention of the Department of Human Services - Division
32 of Aging, Adult and Behavioral Health Services - Community Based Crisis
33 Intervention which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds
34 appropriated in Section 10 of Act 840 of 2017, the following:

4 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

5 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

6 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

7 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and

8 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

9 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal

10 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by

11 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be

12 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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14 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

15 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

16 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for

17 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive

18 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

19 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

20 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

21 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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23 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

24 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of

25 the Department of Human Services - Division of Aging, Adult and Behavioral

26 Health Services are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the

27 Department of Human Services - Division of Aging, Adult and Behavioral Health

28 Services to continue to provide essential governmental services; that the

29 provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the Department

30 of Human Services - Division of Aging, Adult and Behavioral Health Services

31 to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act

32 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of

33 essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared

34 to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the

35 public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and

36 after the date of its passage and approval.

1 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall
2 become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the
3 Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the
4 veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house
5 overrides the veto.
