15 INSPECTOR GENERAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE
16 2018-2019 FISCAL YEAR.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established
23 for the Office of Medicaid Inspector General for the 2018-2019 fiscal year,

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20 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for
 21 the Office of Medicaid Inspector General for the 2018-2019 fiscal year, the
 22 following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as
 23 "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: two
 24 (2) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to
 25 exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or
 26 its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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28 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby
 29 appropriated, to the Office of Medicaid Inspector General, to be payable from
 30 the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, for personal services and operating
 31 expenses of the Office of Medicaid Inspector General for the fiscal year

SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

1 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
2 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
3 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
4 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
5 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
6 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
7 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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9 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
10 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
11 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
12 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
13 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
14 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
15 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
16 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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18 SECTION 10. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1,
19 2018.
