## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES  
9 AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS DEVELOPMENT  
10 FINANCE AUTHORITY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30,  
11 2020; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.  
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## Subtitle

14 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS DEVELOPMENT  
15 FINANCE AUTHORITY APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
16 2019-2020 FISCAL YEAR.  
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
23 Arkansas Development Finance Authority for the 2019-2020 fiscal year, the  
24 following maximum number of regular employees.

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19 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas  
 20 Development Finance Authority for the 2019-2020 fiscal year, the following  
 21 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra  
 22 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: five (5)  
 23 temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed  
 24 those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its  
 25 successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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27 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,  
 28 to the Arkansas Development Finance Authority, to be payable from cash funds

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22 SECTION 7. APPROPRIATION - NATIONAL HOUSING TRUST FUND GRANT. There is

23 hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Development Finance Authority, to be

24 payable from the federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of

25 the State, for personal services and operating expenses for implementation of

26 the Federal Housing Program for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, the

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33 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

34 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

35 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

36 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and

1 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 2 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
 3 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
 4 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
 5 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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 7 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
 8 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
 9 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
 10 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
 11 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
 12 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
 13 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
 14 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 16 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
 17 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits  
 18 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
 19 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of  
 20 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
 21 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
 22 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm  
 23 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
 24 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
 25 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
 26 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019.
