6	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
7	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that certain provisions of the		
8	Arkansas Teacher Retirement System Act, an act that created a state agency		
9	for the purpose of providing retirement benefits to school employees of the		
10	state, are in need of revision and updating to maintain the teacher		
11	retirement laws in conformance with sound public pension policy; that the		
12	Arkansas Teacher Retirement System operates on a fiscal year of July 1 to		
13	June 30; that a July 1, 2019 effective date is necessary to allow the		
14	provisions within this act to begin on the first day of the fiscal year to		
15	provide proper administration of the procedures referenced in this act; that		
16	the updates and revisions to the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System Act are		
17	of great importance for actuarial purposes and the protection of member		
18	benefits under the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System; and that this act is		
19	necessary in order to maintain an orderly system of benefits for the members		
20	of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System. Therefore, an emergency is		
21	declared to exist, and this act being necessary for the preservation of the		
22	public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on July 1, 2019.
