8 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL
9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF
10 EDUCATION - AND ITS VARIOUS DIVISIONS; AND FOR OTHER
11 PURPOSES.

14 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION -
15 AND ITS VARIOUS DIVISIONS
16 REAPPROPRIATION.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION - DEVELOPMENT AND
23 ENHANCEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education,
24 to be payable from the Development and Enhancement Fund, for the Department
25 of Education the following:

26 (A) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
27 in Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 9 of 2018, for computer science initiatives
28 by the Department of Education, in a sum not to exceed\$978,554.
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30 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION - CAPITOL COMPLEX
31 RENOVATION AND REPAIR. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of
32 Education, to be payable from the Educational Buildings Maintenance Fund, for
33 the Department of Education the following:

34 (A) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
35 in Item (A) of Section 2 of Act 9 of 2018, for financing for building and
36 grounds maintenance, equipment maintenance contracts, insurance and



1 janitorial services, major maintenance costs, renovation, improvements,
2 repairs and operations to maintain four (4) buildings owned by the Department
3 of Education located in the Capitol Complex, in a sum not to exceed
4\$3,744,764.
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6 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND -
7 DEVELOPMENT AND ENHANCEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department
8 of Education - Arkansas School for the Blind, to be payable from the
9 Development and Enhancement Fund, for the Department of Education - Arkansas
10 School for the Blind the following:

11 (A) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
12 in Item (A) of Section 5 of Act 9 of 2018, for various maintenance,
13 renovation, equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade, and
14 repair of real property and facilities, in a sum not to exceed\$281,313.

15 (B) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
16 in Item (B) of Section 5 of Act 9 of 2018, for various maintenance,
17 renovation, equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade, and
18 repair of real property and facilities, in a sum not to exceed ...\$4,500,000.
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20 SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND - NCRC
21 GRANTS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education -
22 Arkansas School for the Blind, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and
23 Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Department of Education -
24 Arkansas School for the Blind the following:

25 (A) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
26 in Section 23 of Act 217 of 2018, for acquisition, management, stewardship or
27 preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings, structures or
28 objects, in a sum not to exceed\$378,665.
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30 SECTION 5. REAPPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF - DEVELOPMENT
31 AND ENHANCEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of
32 Education - Arkansas School for the Deaf, to be payable from the Development
33 and Enhancement Fund, for the Department of Education - Arkansas School for
34 the Deaf the following:

35 (A) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
36 in Item (A) of Section 7 of Act 9 of 2018, for various maintenance,

1 renovation, equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade and
2 repair of real property and facilities, in a sum not to exceed\$122,795.

3 (B) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
4 in Item (B) of Section 7 of Act 9 of 2018, for various maintenance,
5 renovation, equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade, and
6 repair of real property and facilities, in a sum not to exceed ..\$19,000,000.

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8 SECTION 6. REAPPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF - NCRC
9 GRANTS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education -
10 Arkansas School for the Deaf, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and
11 Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Department of Education -
12 Arkansas School for the Deaf the following:

13 (A) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
14 in Section 23 of Act 217 of 2018, for the acquisition, management,
15 stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings,
16 structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed\$773,183.

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18 SECTION 7. REAPPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS EDUCATIONAL TELEVISION COMMISSION
19 - DEVELOPMENT AND ENHANCEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the
20 Department of Education - Arkansas Educational Television Commission, to be
21 payable from the Development and Enhancement Fund, for the Department of
22 Education - Arkansas Educational Television Commission the following:

23 (A) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
24 in Item (A) of Section 9 of Act 9 of 2018, for maintenance of state-owned
25 broadcast infrastructure and the network distribution system, and for
26 operating expenses, maintenance and payment of federal and other matching
27 grant requirements by the Department of Education - Arkansas Educational
28 Television Commission, in a sum not to exceed\$3,856,000.

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30 SECTION 8. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
31 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
32 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
33 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
34 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
35 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
36 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State

1 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
2 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
3 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
4 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
5 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

6 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
7 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
8 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of
9 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
10 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
11 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided
12 otherwise by law.

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14 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
15 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
16 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
17 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
18 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
19 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
20 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
21 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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23 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
24 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
25 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
26 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of
27 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
28 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
29 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm
30 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
31 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
32 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
33 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019.
