18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
19

20 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY - JONESBORO -
21 DEVELOPMENT AND ENHANCEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas
22 State University, to be payable from the Development and Enhancement Fund,
23 for the Arkansas State University the following:

24 (A) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
25 in Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 203 of 2018, for construction, renovation,
26 maintenance, equipment, personal services and operating expenses of the
27 various institutions and entities of the Arkansas State University System, in
28 a sum not to exceed\$14,500,000.

29 (B) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
30 in Item (C) of Section 1 of Act 203 of 2018, for construction of a College of
31 Engineering building, in a sum not to exceed\$4,000,000.

32 (C) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
33 in Item (D) of Section 1 of Act 203 of 2018, for College of Education and
34 Communications restrooms renovation, in a sum not to exceed\$908,500.

35 (D) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
36 in Item (E) of Section 1 of Act 203 of 2018, for Library HVAC system



1 renovation and modernization, in a sum not to exceed\$2,000,000.

2 (E) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
3 in Item (F) of Section 1 of Act 203 of 2018, for Lab Sciences Lab and HVAC
4 System renovation and modernization, in a sum not to exceed\$1,291,500.

5 (F) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
6 in Item (G) of Section 1 of Act 203 of 2018, for critical maintenance, in a
7 sum not to exceed\$1,840,000.

8 (G) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
9 in Item (H) of Section 1 of Act 203 of 2018, for deferred maintenance, in a
10 sum not to exceed\$4,940,000.

11 (H) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
12 in Item (I) of Section 1 of Act 203 of 2018, for the purchase, replacement,
13 and renewal of equipment and library holdings, in a sum not to exceed
14\$2,342,774.
15

16 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY - JONESBORO -
17 LAKEPORT PLANTATION DAIRY STABILIZATION. There is hereby appropriated, to
18 the Arkansas State University, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and
19 Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Arkansas State University
20 the following:

21 (A) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
22 in Section 23 of Act 217 of 2018, for the acquisition, management,
23 stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings,
24 structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed\$125,376.
25

26 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY - JONESBORO -
27 KAIT - TV NEWS FILM COLLECTION. There is hereby appropriated, to the
28 Arkansas State University, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and
29 Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Arkansas State University
30 the following:

31 (A) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
32 in Section 23 of Act 217 of 2018, for the acquisition, management,
33 stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings,
34 structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed\$40,000.
35

36 SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY - JONESBORO -

1 SUSTAINABLE BUILDING DESIGN. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas
2 State University, to be payable from the Sustainable Building Design
3 Revolving Loan Fund, for the Arkansas State University the following:

4 (A) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
5 in Section 12 of Act 218 of 2018, for construction, renovation, maintenance
6 and operating expenses, in a sum not to exceed\$1,000,000.
7

8 SECTION 5. REAPPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS TECH UNIVERSITY - DEVELOPMENT AND
9 ENHANCEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Tech University,
10 to be payable from the Development and Enhancement Fund, for the Arkansas
11 Tech University the following:

12 (A) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
13 in Item (A) of Section 4 of Act 203 of 2018, for reroofing the Allied Health
14 Building on the Ozark Campus, in a sum not to exceed\$107,731.

15 (B) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
16 in Item (B) of Section 4 of Act 203 of 2018, for technology upgrades,
17 including a partial renovation of Corley Hall and connecting the Ozark Campus
18 to the AREON, in a sum not to exceed\$5,832,533.

19 (C) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
20 in Item (C) of Section 4 of Act 203 of 2018, for instructional technology in
21 labs for the Ozark Campus, in a sum not to exceed\$244,213.

22 (D) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
23 in Item (D) of Section 4 of Act 203 of 2018, for construction of an academic
24 classroom facility, in a sum not to exceed\$2,367,467.

25 (E) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
26 in Item (E) of Section 4 of Act 203 of 2018, for renovation of restrooms in
27 the Technology and Academic Support building on the Ozark Campus, in a sum
28 not to exceed\$120,589.

29 (F) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
30 in Item (F) of Section 4 of Act 203 of 2018, for critical maintenance, in a
31 sum not to exceed\$300,000.

32 (G) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
33 in Item (G) of Section 4 of Act 203 of 2018, for critical maintenance for the
34 Ozark Campus, in a sum not to exceed\$30,000.

35 (H) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
36 in Item (H) of Section 4 of Act 203 of 2018, for deferred maintenance, in a

1 sum not to exceed\$2,460,000.

2 (I) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
3 in Item (I) of Section 4 of Act 203 of 2018, for purchase, replacement, and

5\$1,361,321.

6 (J) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided

8 Ozark Campus, in a sum not to exceed\$190,000.

9 (K) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided

11 renewal of equipment and library holdings at the Ozark Campus, in a sum not
12 to exceed\$149,510.

18 (A) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
19 in Section 23 of Act 217 of 2018, for the acquisition, management,
20 stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings,
21 structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed\$500,000.

22
23 SECTION 7. REAPPROPRIATION - HENDERSON STATE UNIVERSITY - DEVELOPMENT
24 AND ENHANCEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Henderson State
25 University, to be payable from the Development and Enhancement Fund, for the
26 Henderson State University the following:

27 (A) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
28 in Item (A) of Section 6 of Act 203 of 2018, for construction of a HPER
29 building and renovation of the Wells Building, in a sum not to exceed
30\$3,000,000.

31 (B) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
32 in Item (B) of Section 6 of Act 203 of 2018, for renovation of the Russell
33 Fine Arts Building, in a sum not to exceed\$3,000,000.

34 (C) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
35 in Item (C) of Section 6 of Act 203 of 2018, for construction of a School of
36 Business building and renovation of Mooney Hall, in a sum not to exceed

1\$1,200,000.

20 structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed\$101,814.

27 in Item (C) of Section 8 of Act 203 of 2018, for deferred maintenance, in a
28 sum not to exceed\$124,352.

29 (B) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
30 in Item (D) of Section 8 of Act 203 of 2018, for construction of an
31 Educational building, in a sum not to exceed\$1,350,000.

32 (C) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided

34 improvements and upgrades, in a sum not to exceed\$3,465,750.

19 in Section 23 of Act 217 of 2018, for the acquisition, management,
20 stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings,
21 structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed\$543,043.

23 SECTION 11. REAPPROPRIATION - UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS FOR MEDICAL
24 SCIENCES - DEVELOPMENT AND ENHANCEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the
25 University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences, to be payable from the

28 (A) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided

30 Building to meet code requirements, in a sum not to exceed\$4,200,000.

27 of Arkansas - Fort Smith, to be payable from the Development and Enhancement
28 Fund, for the University of Arkansas - Fort Smith the following:

29 (A) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
30 in Item (B) of Section 21 of Act 203 of 2018, for costs of designing,
31 renovating, and equipping the Math-Science building, in a sum not to exceed
32\$3,000,000.

33 (B) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
34 in Item (C) of Section 21 of Act 203 of 2018, for costs of constructing an
35 expanded Math-Science building, in a sum not to exceed\$2,000,000.

36 (C) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided

1 in Item (D) of Section 21 of Act 203 of 2018, for costs of construction of a
2 College of Business building, in a sum not to exceed\$1,700,000.

3 (D) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided

26 in Item (C) of Section 23 of Act 203 of 2018, for costs of construction of
27 the Institute for Wellness and Restorative Health facility, in a sum not to
28 exceed\$2,100,000.

29 (D) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided
30 in Item (D) of Section 23 of Act 203 of 2018, for costs of construction of a
31 College of Fine Arts and Communication building, in a sum not to exceed
32\$2,100,000.

33 (E) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided

5 SECTION 23. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
6 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
7 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
8 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
9 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
10 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
11 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
12 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
13 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
14 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
15 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
16 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

17 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
18 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
19 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of
20 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
21 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
22 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided
23 otherwise by law.
24

25 SECTION 24. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
26 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
27 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
28 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
29 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
30 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
31 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
32 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
33

34 SECTION 25. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
35 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
36 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the

1 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of
2 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
3 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
4 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm
5 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
6 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
7 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
8 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019.
