8 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES  
9 AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS  
10 COMMUNITY COLLEGE AT RICH MOUNTAIN FOR THE FISCAL  
11 YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2020; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established  
24 for the University of Arkansas Community College at Rich Mountain for the  
25 2019-2020 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the University of Arkansas Community College at Rich Mountain for the 2019-2020 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: eighty (80) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the

1 appropriate classification.

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3 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby  
4 appropriated, to the University of Arkansas Community College at Rich  
5 Mountain, to be payable from the University of Arkansas Community College at  
6 Rich Mountain Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the  
7 University of Arkansas Community College at Rich Mountain for the fiscal year  
8 ending June 30, 2020, the following:

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22 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated,  
23 to the University of Arkansas Community College at Rich Mountain, to be  
24 payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the  
25 University of Arkansas Community College at Rich Mountain, for personal  
26 services and operating expenses of the University of Arkansas Community  
27 College at Rich Mountain for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, the  
28 following:

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9 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
 10 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
 11 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
 12 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
 13 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 14 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures  
 15 Restrictions Act, or their successors or their successors, and other fiscal  
 16 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
 17 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
 18 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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20 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
 21 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
 22 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
 23 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
 24 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
 25 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
 26 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
 27 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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29 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
 30 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
 31 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
 32 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of  
 33 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
 34 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
 35 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm  
 36 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental

1 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
2 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
3 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019.
