7 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2019  
 8 2020 through June 30, ~~2020~~ 2021.

9  
 10 SECTION 40. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SHARED  
 12 SERVICES.

13 (a)(1)(A) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State may create paying  
 14 accounts on his or her books and on the books of the Treasurer of the State  
 15 and Auditor of State for the payment of all personal services and operating  
 16 expenses of the Department of Agriculture.

17 (B) Upon prior approval of the Arkansas Legislative Council, or  
 18 if meeting in Legislative Session the Joint Budget Committee, the Chief  
 19 Fiscal Officer of the state shall direct the transfer of funds and  
 20 appropriations to the Shared Services Paying Account appropriation section of  
 21 this act and the transfer of positions to the Regular Salaries - Shared  
 22 Services appropriation section of this act on the books of the Treasurer of  
 23 State, the Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.

24 (2) The transfer authority provided in subdivision (a)(1) of this section  
 25 for efficiencies and to eliminate duplication of services are limited only to  
 26 those services that are provided for multiple divisions of a department,  
 27 including without limitation to administration, human resources, procurement,  
 28 communications, fleet operations, and information services.

29 (2) The transfer authority provided to the department in  
 30 subdivision (a)(1) of this section may be used to make transfers only within  
 31 the department's appropriation act or between other appropriation acts  
 32 authorized for the department.

33 (b)(1) Each department utilizing the Shared Services Paying Account  
 34 section or Regular Salaries - Shared Services section of this act shall  
 35 submit a report to be included in the Budget Manuals for hearings, conducted  
 36 by the General Assembly, listing all shared services transfers of positions,

1 funds, and appropriation under this section, which shall be submitted as  
2 instructed by the Department of Finance and Administration - Office of Budget  
3 for uniformity.

4 (3) A report submitted under subdivision (b)(1) of this section  
5 shall include the following:

6 (A) The position number, authorized position title, class  
7 code, grade, business area, and name of the division, section, or unit for  
8 the position being transferred to the Regular Salaries - Shared Services  
9 section of this act; and

10 (B) The fund center, appropriation, appropriation amount,  
11 commitment item or items, business area, and name of the division, section,  
12 or unit for the fund or appropriation being transferred to the Shared  
13 Services Paying Account.

14 (c)(1) It is the intent of the Ninety-Second General Assembly that the  
15 authority under this section to transfer positions is intended for use for the  
16 time period prior to Fiscal Year 2022 to allow cabinet-level departments to  
17 establish a centralized Regular Salaries - Shared Services section, with the  
18 recommendation that the position transfer authority granted under this section  
19 be discontinued after that time.

20 (2) The Bureau of Legislative Research shall bring the  
21 recommendation in subdivision (c)(1) of this section to the attention of the  
22 chairs conducting the 2021 Regular Session pre-session budget hearings, the  
23 chairs of the Special Language Subcommittee, and the members of the Special  
24 Language Subcommittee during pre-session budget hearings.

25 (d) Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount  
26 of appropriation and general revenue funding for a cabinet-level department  
27 each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly and is usually  
28 accomplished by delineating the maximums in the appropriation act or acts and  
29 establishing authorized positions and the general revenue allocations  
30 authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the Revenue  
31 Stabilization Law. Further, the General Assembly has determined that the  
32 cabinet-level departments created under Acts 2019, No. 910, may operate more  
33 efficiently if some flexibility is provided as authorized under this section.  
34 Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly  
35 maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or,  
36 if the General Assembly is in session, the Joint Budget Committee, as

1 provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative  
2 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section.  
3 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget  
4 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction,  
5 this entire section is void.

6 (e) The provisions of this section shall be in effect from the date of  
7 passage through June 30, 2021.

8  
9 SECTION 41. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FAIR  
11 WAIVER. The Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission shall waive the rules  
12 under Section (2) of the Commission's Minimum Standards for Receiving Funds  
13 for Premium and Construction Purposes to allow the Three-County Fair,  
14 consisting of Cross, Woodruff, and Jackson counties, to hold the Three-County  
15 Fair after the district fair while receiving the funds from the commission  
16 that the Three-County Fair would receive if the fair were held before the  
17 district fair.

18 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2019~~ 2020  
19 through June 30, ~~2020~~ 2021.

20  
21 SECTION 42. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
22 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
23 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
24 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
25 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
26 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
27 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
28 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
29 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

30  
31 SECTION 43. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
32 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
33 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
34 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
35 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
36 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

1 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
2 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

3  
4 SECTION 44. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
5 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits  
6 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
7 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2020 is essential to the operation of  
8 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
9 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
10 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2020 could work irreparable harm  
11 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
12 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
13 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
14 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2020.
