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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Corrections - Division of Community Corrections for the 2020-2021 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: ten (10) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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19 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COMMUNITY
 21 CORRECTION PROGRAMS LINE ITEM USES. After seeking and receiving approval of
 22 the Governor and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and upon approval by the
 23 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, the Director of the
 24 Department of Community Correction, as authorized by the Board of
 25 Corrections, is authorized to use funds appropriated for "Community
 26 Correction Programs" line item of the Operations - Special Revenue
 27 appropriation provided in this Act to construct new or renovate existing
 28 facilities to support the development of community correction facilities in
 29 the state.

30 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
 31 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
 32 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
 33 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
 34 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
 35 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
 36 has determined that the Department of Community Correction may operate more

1 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Community
2 Correction authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both
3 necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by
4 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
5 as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative
6 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section.

15 FEES. On July 1, of each year the Department of Community Correction shall
16 pay from the appropriation provided herein from non-general revenue, the
17 total amount appropriated for War Memorial Parking Services from Fees to War
18 Memorial.

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22 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
23 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
24 PROVISION. Upon seeking and receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer
25 of the State and review and approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or
26 Joint Budget Committee, the Director of the Department of Community
27 Correction is authorized to transfer appropriation from any line item
28 authorized in the State Operations and Operations - Special Revenue
29 Appropriations of this Act to any other line item authorized in the State
30 Operations and Operations - Special Revenue Appropriations of this Act.
31 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
32 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
33 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
34 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
35 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
36 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly

1 has determined that the Department of Community Correction may operate more
2 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Community
3 Correction authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both
4 necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by
5 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee

16 REALLOCATION OF RESOURCES. Upon determination by the Board of Corrections
17 that a reallocation of resources within the Department of Community
18 Correction and Department of Corrections is necessary for the efficient and
19 effective operation of the departments, the Board, with approval of the
20 Governor and approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
21 Committee, shall have the authority to instruct the department directors, to
22 request from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, a transfer of positions,
23 programs, funds, appropriations, and line-item appropriations within or
24 between existing and newly created divisions, offices, sections, or units of
25 the departments. If it is determined that the requested transfer should be
26 made, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall then initiate the necessary
27 transfer documents to reflect the transfers upon the fiscal records of the
28 State Treasurer, the State Auditor, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,
29 and the Department of Corrections and Department of Community Correction.
30 Provided, however, that the Board shall be limited to submitting no more than
31 two requests, encompassing a single purpose listed in this section, during
32 any fiscal year per department. Transfer authority shall further be limited
33 to no more than five percent (5%) of the total General Revenue and Special
34 Revenue appropriation, funding, and positions specific to each agency.
35 However, there shall be no transfers to or from the County Jail Reimbursement
36 Fund. A Reallocation of Resources Transfer shall be limited to the following

- 1 specific purposes:
- 2 a) Costs to open and operate temporary beds;
 - 3 b) Payment of Debt Service;
 - 4 c) Payment of Overtime Expenses;
 - 5 d) Unanticipated increases for medical or private prison contracts;
 - 6 e) Construction/renovation/equipping of new beds;
 - 7 f) Deficits in Farm or Industry Program;
 - 8 g) Losses not covered by insurance proceeds;
 - 9 h) Costs of personnel for critical services or necessary to carry out the
 - 10 mission of the agency.

11 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
12 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
13 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
14 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
15 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
16 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
17 has determined that the Department of Corrections and the Department of
18 Community Correction may operate more efficiently if some flexibility is
19 provided to the Board of Corrections authorizing broad powers under the
20 Reallocation of Resources provisions herein. Therefore, it is both necessary
21 and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring
22 prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as
23 provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative
24 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section.
25 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
26 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court jurisdiction, this entire
27 section is void.

28 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2019~~
29 2020 through June 30, ~~2020~~ 2021.

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31 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HOLIDAY
33 COMPENSATION. The Department of Community Correction is authorized to pay
34 employees for up to ninety-six (96) hours of unused holidays exceeding a
35 balance in the employee's holiday account of one-hundred fifty (150) hours
36 following the end of the calendar year. Payments of unused holiday hours must

1 be processed on or before June 1st in each fiscal year. Employees terminating
 2 employment from the Department of Community Correction will be eligible for
 3 all holiday pay accrued during the years of service. This request is
 4 contingent on approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State after the
 5 Director of the Department of Community Correction has verified that
 6 sufficient revenues are available to make such payments to employees in the
 7 following classifications:

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 22 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 23 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MEDICAL
 24 SERVICES - CONTINGENCY POSITIONS. If it has been determined by the Board of
 25 Corrections that the Department of Community Correction cannot continue a
 26 medical contract with a private provider and the Board deems it necessary to
 27 utilize Department staff to provide the required services, the Department is
 28 allowed, upon notification of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and after
 29 seeking prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
 30 Committee, to utilize the contingent positions for medical services contained
 31 in this Act and make the appropriate transfers from the Professional Fees and
 32 Services line item contained in the State Operations Appropriation of this
 33 Act to Regular Salaries, Personal Services Matching and various Maintenance
 34 and General Operations classifications. Further, the Department may utilize
 35 the service(s) of a state-based or national-based Professional Recruitment
 36 Service, or network, as may be necessary to recruit, fill, or maintain the

1 occupancy of the positions stated herein.

2 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2019
 3 2020 through June 30, ~~2020~~ 2021.

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4 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
5 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COMMUNITY
6 CORRECTION PROGRAM LINE ITEM USES. After seeking and receiving approval of
7 the Governor and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and upon approval by the
8 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, the Director of the
9 Department of Community Correction, as authorized by the Board of
10 Corrections, is authorized to use the appropriations authorized under the
11 line item established herein for "Community Correction Program" are to be
12 used by the Department of Community Correction for establishment and
13 operation of, to include construction, renovation, and contracting for
14 establishment and operation of, residential and non-residential community
15 correction programs such as, but not limited to, community correction
16 centers, drug, alcohol, and mental health treatments, intensive supervision,
17 restitution, and others as established and approved by the Board of
18 Corrections and as may be provided by law.

19 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2019~~
20 2020 through June 30, ~~2020~~ 2021.

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22 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
23 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
24 AUTHORITY FOR UTILITY AND FUEL RATE INCREASE. In the event of a ten percent
25 (10%) increase in utility and fuel rates, the Department of Community
26 Correction is authorized to transfer from any line item in the State
27 Operations Appropriation to the Operating Expense line item in the State
28 Operations Appropriation for support of the increase after receiving approval
29 of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. Prior to the utilization of the
30 transfer authority a report shall be made to the Arkansas Legislative Council
31 or Joint Budget Committee including justification for the transfer and the
32 amount of transfer.

33 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
34 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
35 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
36 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and

1 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
2 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
3 has determined that the Department of Community Correction may operate more
4 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Community
5 Correction authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is
6 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight
7 by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
8 Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the
9 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this
10 section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint
11 Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent
12 jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

13 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2019~~

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16 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COUNTY
18 JAIL INVOICE SUMMARY. The Department of Corrections and Department of
19 Community Correction, shall at a minimum and on a fiscal year basis, prepare
20 and post on the applicable agency web site, a monthly summary of county jail
21 reimbursement invoices prepared and forwarded to each county sheriff for
22 verification by the Departments and for payment from the County Jail
23 Reimbursement Fund. In addition, the report shall include a summary of
24 invoices returned by each county for payment for previous months within the
25 fiscal year, the amounts paid, and any balances owed. Each fiscal year-end
26 report shall be maintained on the web sites for a period of no less than
27 three (3) years.

28 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2019~~

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31 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

33 VEHICLE PURCHASE PROVISION. The Department of Community Correction is hereby
34 authorized to purchase motor vehicles from the appropriations authorized for
35 Capital Outlay in the State Operations and Special Revenue Operations
36 appropriations in this Act.

1 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2019
2 2020 through June 30, ~~2020~~ 2021.

4 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
5 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

6 PAROLE/PROBATION OFFICERS HIRING. The Department of Community Correction
7 shall report quarterly to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
8 Committee the number of vacant Parole/Probation Officer, Parole/Probation
9 Area Manager, Parole/Probation Assistant Area Manager positions and average
10 case load per Parole/Probation Officer.

11 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2019
12 2020 through June 30, ~~2020~~ 2021.

13
14 SECTION 20. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
15 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
16 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
17 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
18 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
19 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
20 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
21 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
22 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

23
24 SECTION 21. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
25 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
26 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
27 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
28 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
29 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
30 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
31 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

32
33 SECTION 22. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
34 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
35 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
36 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2020 is essential to the operation of

1 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
2 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
3 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2020 could work irreparable harm
4 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
5 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
6 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
7 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2020.
