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22 SECTION 4. EXTRA HELP - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized,
 23 for the Department of Labor and Licensing - Division of Labor for the 2020-
 24 2021 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary
 25 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated
 26 herein for such purposes: two (2) temporary or part-time employees, when
 27 needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform
 28 Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the
 29 appropriate classification.

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 12 SECTION 10. APPROPRIATION - SEMINAR AND CONFERENCE EXPENSES - CASH.

13 There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Labor and Licensing, to be
 14 payable from the cash fund deposited in the State Treasury as determined by
 15 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for operating expenses from the
 16 deposit of registration fees collected for seminars and conferences by the
 17 Department of Labor and Licensing - Division of Labor - Seminar and
 18 Conference Expenses - Cash for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021, the

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 31 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SHARED
 33 SERVICES.

34 (a)(1)(A) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State may create paying
 35 accounts on his or her books and on the books of the Treasurer of State and
 36 the Auditor of State for the payment of personal services and operating

1 expenses by the Department of Labor and Licensing.

2 (B) Upon prior approval of the Arkansas Legislative Council, or
3 if meeting in Legislative Session the Joint Budget Committee, the Chief
4 Fiscal Officer of the State shall direct the transfer of funds and
5 appropriations to the Shared Services Paying Account appropriation section of
6 this act and the transfer of positions to the Regular Salaries – Shared
7 Services appropriation section of this act on the books of the Treasurer of
8 State, the Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.

9 (2) The transfer authority provided in subdivision (a)(1) of
10 this section for efficiencies and to eliminate duplication of services are
11 limited only to those services that are provided for multiple divisions of a
12 department, including without limitation to administration, human resources,
13 procurement, communications, fleet operations, and information services.

14 (3) The transfer authority provided to the department in
15 subdivision (a)(1) of this section may be used to make transfers only within
16 the department's appropriation act or between other appropriation acts
17 authorized for the department.

18 (b)(1) Each department utilizing the Shared Services Paying Account
19 section or Regular Salaries – Shared Services section of this act shall
20 submit a report to be included in the Budget Manuals for hearings, conducted
21 by the General Assembly, listing all shared services transfers of positions,
22 funds, and appropriation under this section, which shall be submitted as
23 instructed by the Department of Finance and Administration - Office of Budget
24 for uniformity.

25 (2) A report submitted under subdivision (b)(1) of this section
26 shall include the following:

27 (A) The position number, authorized position title, class
28 code, grade, business area, and name of the division, section, or unit for
29 the position being transferred to the Regular Salaries – Shared Services
30 section of this act; and

31 (B) The fund center, appropriation, appropriation amount,
32 commitment item or items, business area, and name of the division, section,
33 or unit for the fund or appropriation being transferred to the Shared
34 Services Paying Account.

35 (c)(1) It is the intent of the Ninety-Second General Assembly that the
36 authority under this section to transfer positions is intended for use for

1 the time period prior to Fiscal Year 2022 to allow cabinet-level departments
2 to establish a centralized Regular Salaries - Shared Services section, with
3 the recommendation that the position transfer authority granted under this
4 section be discontinued after that time.

5 (2) The Bureau of Legislative Research shall bring the
6 recommendation in subdivision (c)(1) of this section to the attention of the
7 chairs conducting the 2021 Regular Session pre-session budget hearings, the
8 chairs of the Special Language Subcommittee, and the members of the Special
9 Language Subcommittee during pre-session budget hearings.

10 (d) Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount
11 of appropriation and general revenue funding for a cabinet-level department
12 each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly and is usually
13 accomplished by delineating the maximums in the appropriation act or acts and
14 establishing authorized positions and the general revenue allocations
15 authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the Revenue
16 Stabilization Law. Further, the General Assembly has determined that the
17 cabinet-level departments created under Acts 2019, No. 910, may operate more
18 efficiently if some flexibility is provided as authorized under this section.
19 Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly
20 maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or,
21 if the General Assembly is in session, the Joint Budget Committee, as
22 provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative
23 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section.
24 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
25 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction,
26 this entire section is void.

27 (e) The provisions of this section shall be in effect from the date of
28 passage through June 30, 2021.

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30 SECTION 12. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
31 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
32 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
33 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
34 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
35 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
36 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by

1 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 2 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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 4 SECTION 13. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 5 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 6 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
 7 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
 8 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
 9 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
 10 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
 11 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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13 SECTION 14. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
 14 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
 15 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
 16 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2020 is essential to the operation of
 17 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
 18 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
 19 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2020 could work irreparable harm
 20 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
 21 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
 22 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
 23 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2020.
