11 INTERIM COMMITTEES OF THE ARKANSAS GENERAL ASSEMBLY

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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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25 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established
26 for the Bureau of Legislative Research of the Legislative Council for the
27 2021-2022 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees.

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23 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for
 24 the Bureau of Legislative Research of the Legislative Council for the 2021-
 25 2022 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary
 26 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated
 27 herein for such purposes: thirty-one (31) temporary or part-time employees,
 28 when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform
 29 Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the
 30 appropriate classification.

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32 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,
 33 to the Bureau of Legislative Research of the Legislative Council, to be
 34 payable from the State Central Services Fund, for personal services,
 35 operating expenses, contingency, committee rooms, and construction and
 36 capital improvements of the Bureau of Legislative Research and the

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29 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - INTERIM COMMITTEE EXPENSES. There is hereby
 30 appropriated, to the Bureau of Legislative Research of the Legislative
 31 Council Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the State Central Services
 32 Fund, for paying per diem, expenses and mileage to members of the Arkansas
 33 General Assembly attending regular and special meetings and other committee
 34 related activities of the Ad Interim Committees of the Arkansas General
 35 Assembly, and for out-of-state travel expenses for committee staff as
 36 approved by the appropriate committee for the fiscal year ending June 30,

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14 SECTION 6. APPROPRIATION - ENERGY COUNCIL. There is hereby
 15 appropriated, to the Bureau of Legislative Research of the Legislative
 16 Council Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the State Central Services
 17 Fund, for paying expenses of members of the Arkansas General Assembly
 18 attending meetings of the Energy Council and for other associated expenses
 19 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, the following:

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26 SECTION 7. REAPPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Bureau
 27 of Legislative Research of the Legislative Council, to be payable from the
 28 State Central Services Fund, from the balance of the appropriation remaining
 29 on June 30, 2021 in Sections 3 and 7 of Act 148 of 2020, there to be used for
 30 the same purposes for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, in a sum not to
 31 exceed..... \$2,000,000.

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33 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
 35 PROVISION - LINE ITEMS. The Director of the Bureau of Legislative Research
 36 is hereby authorized to direct the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to

1 transfer appropriation between line items within appropriations and also
 2 between the appropriations made by this Act in such amounts as determined
 3 necessary.

4 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2020~~
 5 2021 through June 30, ~~2021~~ 2022.

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 7 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COST OF
 9 LIVING INCREASES. Employees of the Bureau of Legislative Research assigned
 10 to positions having a labor grade shall be eligible for cost-of-living
 11 increases on July 1, in an amount equal to that granted to all other state
 12 agency, board, commission or institution of higher education employees on
 13 those dates. Any additional adjustments in annual salary rates for Bureau
 14 employees, labor market adjustments, merit pay adjustments or employee
 15 retention or recruitment requirements shall be made at the discretion of the
 16 Director of the Bureau. Salary payments shall not be restricted to maximum
 17 amounts authorized by law, if the salary adjustments exceed the maximum line
 18 item amount authorized by law for a position, the amount shall be paid to the
 19 employee as a lump-sum payment.

20 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2020~~
 21 2021 through June 30, ~~2021~~ 2022.

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 23 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 24 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
 25 DISBURSING OFFICER. The Director of the Bureau of Legislative Research of the
 26 Legislative Council shall be the disbursing officer for the funds
 27 appropriated by this Act, including the Interim Committee Study Expenses. The
 28 Director shall appoint a designee who shall serve as the disbursing officer
 29 in his/her absence. In the event there is no Director, the Co-Chairs of the
 30 Arkansas Legislative Council can appoint a disbursing officer. All
 31 expenditures from the appropriations provided by this Act shall be in
 32 accordance with procedures established by the Legislative Council and in
 33 accordance with appropriate law.

34 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2020~~
 35 2021 through June 30, ~~2021~~ 2022.

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SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
 CLASSIFICATION UTILIZATION. The Bureau of Legislative Research may utilize,
 at the discretion of the Director of the Bureau of Legislative Research, the
 following classifications as necessary. The use of these classifications
 shall not be considered as increasing the number of positions authorized in
 this act, only as a temporary reclassification or cross grade of a position.

1 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020
2 2021 through June 30, ~~2021~~ 2022.

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4 SECTION 12. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
5 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
6 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
7 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
8 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
9 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
10 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
11 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
12 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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14 SECTION 13. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
15 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
16 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
17 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
18 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
19 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
20 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
21 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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23 SECTION 14. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
24 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
25 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
26 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the operation of
27 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
28 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
29 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2021 could work irreparable harm
30 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
31 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
32 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
33 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2021.
