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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established
24 for the University of Arkansas Community College at Batesville for the 2021-
25 2022 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees.

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12 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for

13 the University of Arkansas Community College at Batesville for the 2021-2022

14 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary

15 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated

16 herein for such purposes: one hundred (100) temporary or part-time

17 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the

18 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act

19 for the appropriate classification.

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21 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby

22 appropriated, to the University of Arkansas Community College at Batesville,

23 to be payable from the University of Arkansas Community College at Batesville

24 Fund, for personal services of the University of Arkansas Community College

25 at Batesville for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, the following:

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34 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated,

35 to the University of Arkansas Community College at Batesville, to be payable

36 from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801, for personal services

1 and operating expenses of the University of Arkansas Community College at
 2 Batesville for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, the following:

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23 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
 24 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
 25 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
 26 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 27 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 28 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures
 29 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
 30 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
 31 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
 32 with in disbursement of said funds.

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34 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 35 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 36 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for

1 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
2 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
3 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
4 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
5 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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7 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
8 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
9 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
10 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the operation of
11 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
12 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
13 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2021 could work irreparable harm
14 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
15 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
16 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
17 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2021.
