22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
25 Department of Energy and Environment - Oil and Gas Commission for the 2021-
26 2022 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees.

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10 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Department
 11 of Energy and Environment - Oil and Gas Commission for the 2021-2022 fiscal
 12 year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be
 13 known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such
 14 purposes: six (6) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of
 15 pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and
 16 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate
 17 classification.

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19 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,
 20 to the Department of Energy and Environment, to be payable from the Oil and
 21 Gas Commission Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the
 22 Department of Energy and Environment - Oil and Gas Commission for the fiscal
 23 year ending June 30, 2022, the following:

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10 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - REFUNDS AND REIMBURSEMENTS. There is hereby

11 appropriated, to the Department of Energy and Environment, to be payable from

12 cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801, for refunds and

13 reimbursements of the Department of Energy and Environment - Oil and Gas

14 Commission - Refunds and Reimbursements for the fiscal year ending June 30,

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21 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - WELL PLUGGING PROGRAM. There is hereby

22 appropriated, to the Department of Energy and Environment, to be payable from

23 the Abandoned and Orphaned Well Plugging Fund, for well plugging program

24 expenses of the Department of Energy and Environment - Oil and Gas Commission

25 - Well Plugging Program for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, the

26 following:

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32 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

33 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND

34 TRANSFER. The Oil and Gas Commission, after receiving review from the Chief

35 Fiscal Officer of the State and reporting to the Arkansas Legislative Council

36 or Joint Budget Committee, may request the Chief Fiscal Officer to transfer

1 up to ~~\$2,000,000~~ \$1,000,000 per year on his or her books and the books of the
2 State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State from the Oil and Gas Commission
3 Fund to the Abandoned and Orphaned Well Plugging Fund.

4 The Oil and Gas Commission may request the Chief Fiscal Officer to
5 transfer \$10,000,000 in a one time, emergency transfer on his or her books
6 and the books of the State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State from the
7 Oil and Gas Commission Fund to the Abandoned and Orphaned Well Plugging Fund.

8 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2020~~
9 2021 through June 30, ~~2021~~ 2022.

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11 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
12 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
13 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
14 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
15 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
16 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
17 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
18 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
19 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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21 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
22 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
23 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
24 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
25 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
26 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
27 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
28 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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30 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
31 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
32 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
33 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the operation of
34 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
35 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
36 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2021 could work irreparable harm

1 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
2 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
3 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
4 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2021.
