29	(b)(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the
30	right to utilize a working animal for the benefit and welfare of the working
31	animal or the individual the working animal serves is guaranteed.
32	(2) An ordinance or resolution shall not be enacted by a
33	municipality that terminates, bans, effectively bans, or creates an undue
34	hardship relating to the job or use of a working animal or animal enterprise
35	in commerce, service, legal hunting, agriculture, husbandry, transportation,
36	ranching, entertainment, education, or exhibition.



1	(c) This section does not alter state laws or rules that regulate
2	animal care, public health, or public safety, including without limitation §

4	(d) This section does not prohibit a municipality from establishing or
