8 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES
9 AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS STATE
10 UNIVERSITY - MID-SOUTH WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL
11 AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ACT 23
12 OF 2020; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

15 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY
16 - MID-SOUTH SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby
23 appropriated, to the Arkansas State University - Mid-South, to be payable
24 from the Arkansas State University Mid-South Fund, for personal services of
25 the Arkansas State University - Mid-South which shall be supplemental and in
26 addition to those funds appropriated in Section 3 of Act 23 of 2020, the
27 following:

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35 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - ADTEC/UNIVERSITY CENTER PARTNERS. There is
36 hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas State University - Mid-South, to be



1 payable from the Arkansas State University Mid-South Fund, for personal
 2 services, operating expenses, equipment and grants to Arkansas Delta Training
 3 and Education Consortium (ADTEC) Partners and University Center Partners of
 4 the Arkansas State University - Mid-South which shall be supplemental and in
 5 addition to those funds appropriated in Section 5 of Act 23 of 2020, the
 6 following:

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 12 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
 13 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
 14 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
 15 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 16 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 17 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 18 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 19 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 20 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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 22 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 23 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 24 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
 25 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
 26 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
 27 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
 28 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
 29 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 31 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
 32 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of
 33 the Arkansas State University - Mid-South are, due to unforeseen
 34 circumstances, insufficient for the Arkansas State University - Mid-South to
 35 continue to provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of
 36 this act will provide the necessary monies for the Arkansas State University

1 - Mid-South to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date
 2 of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and
 3 provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is
 4 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate
 5 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force
 6 and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

7 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall
 8 become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the
 9 Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the
 10 veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house
 11 overrides the veto.
