## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT CONCERNING SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARDS OF DIRECTORS; TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE APPOINTMENT OF AN INDIVIDUAL TO A VACANCY ON A SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE APPOINTMENT OF AN INDIVIDUAL TO A VACANCY ON A SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-13-611(c), concerning appointment of an individual to a vacancy on a school district board of directors, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:
(c) If a vacancy occurs on the school district board of directors, the vacancy shall be filled by the appointment of an individual who is a qualified elector of the school district and who resides in the same zone, if applicable, as required by the vacant position by either:
(1) A majority vote of the remaining directors; of within:
(A) Thirty (30) days for vacancies resulting under
subdivisions (a)(1)-(7) of this section; or
(B) Sixty (60) days for vacancies resulting under
subdivision (a) (8) of this section; or
(2) The county quorum court if:
(A) As a result of several vacancies on the school district board of directors, only a minority of board members remains; or
(B) The school board of directors fails to fill the vacancy within thirty (30) days the time permitted under subdivision (c)(1)(A) or (c)(1)(B) of this section.
