8 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL
9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF
10 PARKS, HERITAGE, AND TOURISM - STATE PARKS AND
11 TOURISM DIVISIONS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

14 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS,
15 HERITAGE, AND TOURISM - STATE PARKS AND
16 TOURISM DIVISIONS REAPPROPRIATION.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - NCRC GRANT. There is hereby appropriated,
23 to the Department of Parks, Heritage, and Tourism, to be payable from the
24 Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the
25 Department of Parks, Heritage, and Tourism - State Parks and Tourism
26 Divisions the following:

27 (A) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided
28 in Section 24 of Act 832 of 2021, for grants for the acquisition, management,
29 stewardship, or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings,
30 structures, or objects, in a sum not to exceed.....\$9,750,000.
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32 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated,
33 to the Department of Parks, Heritage, and Tourism, to be payable from the
34 cash fund deposited in the State Treasury as determined by the Chief Fiscal
35 Officer of the State, for the Department of Parks, Heritage, and Tourism -
36 State Parks and Tourism Divisions the following:



1 (A) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided
2 in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 216 of 2021, for maintenance and replacement
3 of Field Turf of War Memorial Stadium, in a sum not to exceed\$435,000.

4 (B) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided
5 in Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 216 of 2021, for maintenance, renovation,
6 equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade and repair of the
7 Southwest Concourse Restrooms of War Memorial Stadium, in a sum not to exceed
8\$42,500.

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10 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - CAPITAL PROJECTS. There is hereby
11 appropriated, to the Department of Parks, Heritage, and Tourism, to be
12 payable from the Development and Enhancement Fund, for the Department of
13 Parks, Heritage, and Tourism - State Parks and Tourism Divisions the
14 following:

15 (A) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided
16 in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 862 of 2021, for the Delta Heritage Trail
17 State Park - Phase VIII Trail Development Mellwood to Snow Lake section, in a
18 sum not to exceed\$5,222,675.

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20 SECTION 4. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
21 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
22 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
23 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
24 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
25 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
26 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
27 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
28 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
29 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
30 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
31 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

32 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
33 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
34 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of
35 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
36 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in

1 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided
2 otherwise by law.

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4 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
5 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
6 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
7 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
8 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
9 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
10 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
11 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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13 SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1,
14 2022.
