22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established

36 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for

1 the Department of Human Services - Division of Developmental Disabilities  
 2 Services for the 2023-2024 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-  
 3 time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds  
 4 appropriated herein for such purposes: two hundred (200) temporary or part-  
 5 time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in  
 6 the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this  
 7 act for the appropriate classification.

 9 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,

31 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.  
33 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES - GRANTS TO COMMUNITY BASED PROVIDERS. Funds  
34 allocated for community-based services under the appropriation for (i) the  
35 Grants-in-Aid appropriation in this act, (ii) the Grants/Patient Services  
36 Line in the Operations appropriation in this act, and (iii) the Inter-



1 Divisional Programs appropriation in this act, shall be used only to provide  
2 services through private community based services licensed or certified by  
3 the Arkansas Division of Developmental Disabilities Services (DDS) or  
4 licensed or certified by a Provider-Led Arkansas Shared Savings Entity  
5 (PASSE). Non-profit community-based programs licensed by the Division of  
6 Developmental Disabilities Services are quasi-governmental instrumentalities  
7 of the state which provide supports and services to individuals who have a  
8 developmental disability or delay, who would otherwise require supports and  
9 services through state-operated programs and facilities owned by the State of  
10 Arkansas. When licensed providers are involved in delivering services which  
11 are Medicaid reimbursable, they must enroll as a provider with the Arkansas  
12 Medicaid Program and must bill the Arkansas Medicaid Program for all covered  
13 services for eligible individuals.

14 Services which are covered by the Arkansas State Medicaid Program,  
15 including the Provider-Led Arkansas Shared Savings Entity (PASSE) model, will  
16 be utilized to the maximum extent possible for any individual who is eligible  
17 for Medicaid coverage. It is the intent of this section that DDS, as a  
18 general policy, maximize the use of Medicaid funding available for  
19 appropriate services.

20 Licensed private community providers funded from these appropriations for  
21 community based services shall:

22 1. Screen each individual to whom services are provided for a determination  
23 of eligibility or ineligibility for Medicaid coverage within thirty days of  
24 the first date that services are provided.

25 2. Meet minimum standards of performance in the delivery of services to  
26 people with disabilities as defined by the Department of Human Services -  
27 Division of Developmental Disabilities Services.

28 3. Supply statistical and financial data to the Department of Human Services  
29 - Division of Developmental Disabilities Services.

30 4. Establish and maintain a sound financial management system in accordance  
31 with guidelines as set forth by the Department of Human Services.

32 5. Establish and maintain community support programs designed to provide  
33 coordinated care and treatment to ensure ongoing involvement and  
34 individualized services for persons with disabilities.

35 It is the intent of this section to insure that wherever possible and  
36 appropriate, Medicaid funds are utilized.

1 Nothing in this Act shall prevent the Division or any provider from  
2 extending emergency services when appropriate measures have been taken in a  
3 timely manner to secure Medicaid eligibility.

4 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2022~~  
5 2023 through June 30, ~~2023~~ 2024.

6  
7 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE – CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code Title 20,  
8 Chapter 48, Subchapter 4, is amended to add additional sections and to codify  
9 special language in appropriation acts to read as follows:

10 20-48-418. Vocational trainees.

11 The Division of Developmental Disabilities Services may provide  
12 employment opportunities for individuals with developmental disabilities who:

- 13 (1) Reside at a human development center; and
- 14 (2) Who work at a less than competitive employment level.

15  
16 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE – CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code Title 20,  
17 Chapter 48, Subchapter 4, is amended to add additional sections and to codify  
18 special language in appropriation acts to read as follows:

19 20-48-419. Prohibition on closure of human development centers.

20 (a) The Board of Developmental Disabilities Services and the  
21 Department of Human Services shall not close any of the existing five (5)  
22 human development centers.

23  
24 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

26 ELIMINATION OF AUTISM WAIVER SERVICES WAITING LIST. Immediately upon the  
27 effective date of this Act, the Department of Human Services - Division of  
28 Developmental Disabilities Services shall budget, allocate, and expend up to  
29 one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the elimination of the Autism Waiver  
30 Services Program waiting list.

31 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  
32 ~~2022~~ 2023 through June 30, ~~2023~~ 2024.

33  
34 SECTION 14. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
35 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
36 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

1 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
2 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
3 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
4 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
5 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
6 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

7  
8 SECTION 15. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
9 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
10 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
11 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
12 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
13 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
14 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
15 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

16  
17 SECTION 16. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
18 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits  
19 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
20 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2023 is essential to the operation of  
21 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
22 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
23 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2023 could work irreparable harm  
24 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
25 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
26 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
27 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2023.
