1 forty-five (45) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of
 2 pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and
 3 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate
 4 classification.

14 SECTION 12. APPROPRIATION - HELP AMERICA VOTE ACT - FEDERAL. There is
15 hereby appropriated, to the Secretary of State, to be payable from the
16 federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for
17 expenditures requiring state matching for maintenance, operating expenses and
18 associated costs for the Help America Vote Act for the fiscal year ending
19 June 30, 2027, the sum of.....\$4,000,000.

21 SECTION 13. APPROPRIATION - GIFT SHOP AND CAFE. There is hereby
22 appropriated, to the Secretary of State, to be payable from the cash funds as
23 defined by Arkansas Code §19-4-801, for personal services and miscellaneous
24 operating expenses of the Gift Shop and Cafe of the Secretary of State for
25 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2027, the sum of.....\$490,000.

27 SECTION 14. APPROPRIATION - BUSINESS AND COMMERCIAL SERVICES ELECTRONIC
28 FILING SYSTEM. There is hereby appropriated, to the Secretary of State, to
29 be payable from the Secretary of State Business and Commercial Services
30 Electronic Filing System Fund, for the maintenance and support of the
31 business and commercial services electronic filing system of the Business and
32 Commercial Services Electronic Filing System for the fiscal year ending June
33 30, 2027, the sum of.....\$1,080,000.

35 SECTION 15. APPROPRIATION - SECURITY. There is hereby appropriated, to
36 the Secretary of State, to be payable from the cash funds deposited in the

1 State Treasury as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for
2 security of the Arkansas State Capitol and grounds for the fiscal year ending
3 June 30, 2027, the sum of.....\$3,100,000.
4

5 SECTION 16. APPROPRIATION - HVAC UPGRADE. There is hereby
6 appropriated, to the Secretary of State, to be payable from the cash funds
7 deposited in the State Treasury as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of
8 the State, for HVAC upgrade to North End of State Capitol building for the
9 fiscal year ending June 30, 2027, the sum of.....\$9,100,000.
10

11 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
13 TRANSFER PROVISION. After receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer
14 of the State, and prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
15 Budget Committee, the Agency is authorized to transfer appropriation from any
16 line item authorized in Operations appropriation to any other line item
17 authorized in Operations appropriation.

18 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2025~~
19 2026 through June 30, ~~2026~~ 2027.
20

21 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
23 PERMANENT GIFT SHOP. The Arkansas Secretary of State shall operate a gift
24 shop to be permanently located in a space on the first floor of the State
25 Capitol Building. It shall be the duty of the Secretary of State to maintain
26 a space on the first floor of the State Capitol Building for the use of a
27 gift shop. The Arkansas Secretary of State is prohibited from removing a
28 gift shop from the first floor of the State Capitol Building or to nullify or
29 void the provisions of this section. A space on the first floor of the State
30 Capitol Building shall be the only location for the Arkansas Secretary of
31 State gift shop operations and shall be the only location items of the
32 Arkansas Secretary of State gift shop are sold to the public.
33

34 SECTION 19. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
35 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
36 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

1 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
2 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
3 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
4 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
5 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
6 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

7
8 SECTION 20. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
9 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
10 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
11 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
12 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
13 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
14 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
15 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

16
17 SECTION 21. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
18 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
19 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
20 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2026 is essential to the operation of
21 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
22 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
23 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2026 could work irreparable harm
24 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
25 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
26 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
27 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2026.
