Act 184 HB1364

"AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR - EMPLOYMENT SECURITY DIVISION FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1989; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for the Department of Labor - Employment Security Division for the 1987-89 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees and the grades to be assigned to the respective positions, and the maximum annual salaries for each such position shall be determined in accordance with, but shall not exceed the maximum annual amount, for the grades assigned herein, as established in Section 5 of Act 199 of 1969, as amended, the same being the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. Except where otherwise specifically provided herein, the Classification and Compensation Plan of the Agency shall be governed by Act 199 of 1969, as amended, with respect to grade assignments, class titles, position reclassifications, salary adjustments, special entry rates, and salary increase eligibility requirements. The Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act shall be applicable to all positions contained herein.

In addition to the following positions, extra help and additional regular positions are authorized by this Act only as provided in Section 2, EXTRA HELP, and Section 11, ADDITIONAL POSITIONS.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Labor - Employment Security Division for the 1987-89 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: four hundred (400) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, for the appropriate classification. Any of these positions utilized in a manner which are funded by federal sources are specifically exempt from limitation of hours, either by Act or Regulation.

SECTION 3. OVERTIME. The Employment Security Division is authorized to pay overtime pay for overtime work to State employees covered by this

appropriation act in accordance with Act 876 of 1973, as amended, and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.

SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Labor - Employment Security Division, to be payable from the cash funds of the Department of Labor - Employment Security Division, for personal services and operating expenses of the Department of Labor - Employment Security Division for the biennial period ending June 30, 1989, the following:

No part of the funds hereby appropriated may be obligated after the expiration of the two year period beginning on the date of enactment of this Act in accordance with above referenced Section 903 of the Social Security Act, as amended.

The amount obligated pursuant to this Act during any twelve-month period shall not exceed the amount by which (1) the aggregate of the amounts credited to the account of the State pursuant to Section 903 of the Social Security Act, as amended, during the same twelve-month period and the thirty-four (34) preceding twelve-month periods, exceeds (2) the aggregate of the amounts obligated for administration and paid out for the benefits and charged against the amounts credited to the account of the State during such thirty-five (35) twelve-month periods beginning on July 1 and ending on the next, June 30.

SECTION 6. APPROPRIATIONS - ESD SPECIAL FUND. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Labor - Employment Security Division, to be payable from the Employment Security Special Fund, for the use of the Department of Labor - Employment Security Division for the biennial period

ending June 30, 1989, the following:

SECTION 8. APPROPRIATIONS - EXCESS UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS AND EXPENSES. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Labor - Employment Security Division, to be payable from the Employment Security Special Fund, for the payment of unemployment benefits and of expenses incurred in the administration of the Employment Security Law when such expenses exceed funds available from other sources for services performed and/or costs incurred in the administration of such law by the Department of Labor - Employment Security Division for the biennial period ending June 30, 1989, the following:

SECTION 9. APPROPRIATIONS - JOBS TRAINING PARTNERSHIP ACT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Labor - Employment Security Division, to be payable from the Department of Labor - Employment Security Division Federal Fund, for grant payments of the Jobs Training Partnership Act by the Department of Labor - Employment Security Division for the biennial period ending June 30, 1989, the following:

SECTION 10. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Labor - Employment Security Division, to be payable from the Employment Security Advance Interest Trust Fund, to allow transfer of funds from the Advance Interest Trust Fund to the Unemployment Insurance Trust Fund, for payment of unemployment insurance benefits, and to pay Unemployment Insurance Trust Fund loan interest, if needed, for the biennial period ending June 30, 1989, the following:

SECTION 11. ADDITIONAL POSITIONS. The Administrator of the Employment Security Division, after receiving the approval of the Office of Personnel Management, and after seeking the advice of the Arkansas Legislative Council, shall have the authority to establish such new or additional full time positions as may become necessary to carry out the objectives of the program and/or to meet Federal requirements of new and/or expanded programs where such needs are financed by federal funds; provided that not more than two hundred persons may be employed in addition to those authorized in the salary schedule and that the rate of pay shall not exceed those set out in the salary schedule for comparable positions as authorized under the provisions of Section 1 of this Act.

Furthermore, the Administrator of the Employment Security Division, after receiving the approval of the Office of Personnel Management, and after seeking the advice of the Arkansas Legislative Council, shall have the authority to add or transfer one (1) position to the State Board of Review if federal funding becomes available.

SECTION 12. TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATION. Subject to such rules and regulations as may be implemented by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and after having sought the advice of the Arkansas Legislative Council, the Administrator of the Employment Security Division is hereby authorized to make transfers from any appropriation made by this Act to any other appropriation made by this Act with the exception of the "Reed Act Funds" appropriations set forth in Section 5 of this Act, and of the appropriation made for Regular Salaries or Maintenance and General Operation. Such transfers may be made whenever it appears, by projecting the expenditures of any of the appropriations in this Act, that there will be a deficiency of appropriation in one item and that there will be a corresponding excess of appropriation in another item or items which may be transferred. The transfer of appropriation shall be effected only on approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. Provided, however, that no transfer of appropriations may be authorized to increase the total amount appropriated for Regular Salaries, or Maintenance and General Operations, except as may be authorized elsewhere by law.

SECTION 13. CARRY FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of appropriation made by this Act, with the exception of appropriation made for Regular Salaries and Maintenance and General Operation, which remains at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1988, shall be transferred forward and made available for the same purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1989.

SECTION 14. SERVICE TO FOOD STAMP APPLICANTS. To insure that job finding assistance is being adequately provided to food stamp applicants and recipients, the Employment Security Division shall periodically station appropriate staff for some portion of a work day in each county or district office of the Department of Human Services. The Administrator of the Employment Security Division and the Director of the Department of Human Services shall enter into a written agreement regarding the provision of such services to food stamp applicants, provided the Employment Security Division has federal funds available and specifically identified for use in providing such services.

SECTION 15. REPORTING. The Employment Security Division shall report quarterly to the Arkansas Legislative Council the number of registrants or

recipients of Food Stamps interviewed, the number of job referrals made, and the number of registrants or recipients of Food Stamps placed in jobs. This report shall be made for each county or district office; provided the Employment Security Division has federal funds available and specifically identified for use in providing such services.

SECTION 16. RESTRICTIONS. Upon approval and implementation of the Office of Personnel Management's (OPM) classification recommendations of September 17, 1984, to be effective July 1, 1985, incumbents who occupied specified positions in the following recommended classifications or titles on or before September 17, 1984, and who remain in those classifications and/or specified positions, shall continue to be paid at the grade authorized for that classification and position which was in effect on June 30, 1985. Employees who entered these classifications and/or specified positions after September 17, 1984, shall be paid at the OPM recommended classification and pay grade, as specified below:

SECTION 17. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 18. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which

this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 19. CONTRACT RESTRICTIONS. The agency, board, commission, department or institution to whom funds are appropriated by this Act shall not enter into any contract for any professional or consultant services which shall extend for more than twenty (20) actual working days or the total compensation exceeds five thousand dollars (\$5,000) during any one fiscal year without first seeking the advice of the Arkansas Legislative Council. Provided further, that all contracts for professional or consultant services shall be submitted monthly to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State for reporting to the Legislative Council.

SECTION 20. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Sixth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1987 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1987 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1987.
