Act 26 HB1187

"AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 1 OF ACT 862 OF 1981 [ARK. STAT. 41-2918.1] TO MAKE UNLAWFUL DOG FIGHTING A MISDEMEANOR AND TO PRESCRIBE PENALTIES THEREFOR; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Act 862 of 1981, the same being Arkansas Statutes 41-2918.1, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. (a) A person commits the offense of unlawful dog fighting if he knowingly:

- (1) promotes, engages in, or is employed at dog fighting;
- (2) receives money for the admission of another person to a place kept for dog fighting;
  - (3) sells, purchases, possesses, or trains a dog for dog fighting;
- (4) purchases a ticket of admission to or is present at a dog fight;
  - (5) witnesses a dog fight if it is presented as a public spectacle.
- (b) Unlawful dog fighting is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) nor more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000) and by imprisonment of not more than one (1) year.
- (c) In addition to the penalties imposed under subsection (b) of this Act, the court can require the defendant to make restitution to the State, any of its political subdivisions, or a lawfully organized humane society, for housing, feeding or providing medical treatment to dogs used for unlawful fighting."
- SECTION 2. (a) Section 2 of Act 862 of 1981, the same being Arkansas Statute 41-2918.2, is hereby repealed.
- (b) All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
