Act 359 SB138

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR A REASONABLE FEE FOR THE PROCESSING OF MEDICAL RECORDS SOUGHT TO BE DISCOVERED IN A CIVIL ACTION: AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. A party in a civil action who seeks discovery of medical records from a physician or a hospital may be required by the court to pay the person from whom discovery is sought a reasonable fee for processing the records. The fee for processing the records shall not be limited to the expense for copying the records.

 $\tt SECTION\ 2.$ All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
