Act 391 HB1189

"AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES OF THE STATE FORESTRY COMMISSION FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1989; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - GENERAL OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for the State Forestry Commission for the 1987-89 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act, or its successor.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - GENERAL OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the State Forestry Commission for the 1987-89 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: one hundred thirty-eight (138) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - GENERAL OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the State Forestry Commission, to be payable from the State Forestry Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the State Forestry Commission - General Operations for the biennial period ending June 30, 1989, the following:

SECTION 6. APPROPRIATIONS - EMERGENCY FIRE PROGRAM. There is hereby appropriated, to the State Forestry Commission, to be payable from the Emergency Fire Trust Fund, for personal services, fire control and communications of the State Forestry Commission - Emergency Fire Program for the biennial period ending June 30, 1989, the following:

SECTION 7. APPROPRIATIONS - RURAL COMMUNITY FIRE PROTECTION GRANTS. There is hereby appropriated, to the State Forestry Commission, to be payable from the Forestry Rural Fire Equipment Fund, for grants to rural communities by the State Forestry Commission - Rural Community Fire Protection Grants for the biennial period ending June 30, 1989, the following:

SECTION 8. TRANSFER PROVISION. During either fiscal year of the 1987-89 biennium, any savings made in appropriations for the payment of salaries to Forest towermen included in items (1), (2), and (3) of Section 3 herein may, upon the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, be transferred to the appropriation made either in items (1), (3) or (5) of Section 3 for the inclusion in the proper category of employment of aircraft pilots, foresters or maintenance and operation of aircraft, and/or for purchase of aircraft to be used in wild fire detection.

In the event the State Forestry Commission determines the nursery operation can effectively maintain its self-supporting status by utilization of contract labor from a private vendor for temporary and/or seasonal labor needs, the Commission is hereby authorized, upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer to transfer the necessary appropriation authorized by Item (02) in Section 3 of this Act to Item (05) in Section 3 of this Act.

SECTION 9. FIELD AUDITORS. It is the intent of the General Assembly that two (2) of the Field Auditor II positions authorized in Section 1 of this Act shall be used primarily for performing audits and other services to assure that the severance tax on timber including wood chips and the Forest Fire Protection Tax due to the Forestry Commission is paid.

SECTION 10. During the 1987-89 biennium, positions authorized as Forester I and Aircraft Pilot I may be downgraded to Forest Towerman to provide for an orderly transition to complete aerial wildfire detection and reorganization of districts to county units.

SECTION 11. EXTRA HELP - EMERGENCY FIRE PROGRAM. There is hereby authorized, for the State Forestry Commission - Emergency Fire Program for the 1987-89 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: fifty (50) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 12. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 13. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 14. CONTRACT RESTRICTIONS. The agency, board, commission, department or institution to whom funds are appropriated by this Act shall not enter into any contract for any professional or consultant services which shall extend for more than twenty (20) actual working days or the total compensation exceeds five thousand dollars (\$5,000) during any one fiscal year without first seeking the advice of the Arkansas Legislative Council. Provided further, that all contracts for professional or consultant services shall be submitted monthly to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State for reporting to the Legislative Council.

SECTION 15. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Sixth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1987 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1987 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being

necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1987.
