Act 402 HB1499

"AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION - SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1989; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Department of Education - School for the Blind for the 1987-89 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act, or its successor.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Education - School for the Blind for the 1987-89 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: twelve (12) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - STATE. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education - School for the Blind, to be payable from the School for the Blind Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the Department of Education - School for the Blind - State for the biennial period ending June 30, 1989, the following:

SECTION 6. APPROPRIATIONS - BRAILLE TEXTBOOKS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education - School for the Blind, to be payable from the School for the Blind Fund Account, for the purchase of Braille and Large Print Textbooks for visually impaired and blind students attending public schools in Arkansas by the Department of Education - School for the Blind for the biennial period ending June 30, 1989, the following:

SECTION 7. The State Board of Education shall make reasonable rules and regulations to implement the Braille and Large Print Textbooks appropriation and is hereby authorized to negotiate directly with publishers of Braille and Large Print Textbooks for the purchase of such textbooks.

SECTION 8. The Superintendents of the Arkansas Schools for the Deaf and Blind are hereby authorized to advance employees classified as Regional Specialists for the Sensory Impaired (Grade 17) to Education Field Services Specialist for the Sensory Impaired (Grade 19) and surrender the lower graded position for the higher graded position, after seeking the advice of the Arkansas Legislative Council, and upon certification to, and approval by, the Office of Personnel Management of the Department of Finance and Administration of employee's satisfaction of the following requirements: a Master's degree from a duly accredited institution of higher education in a teaching related

area, certification by the Department of Education in the appropriate subject and grade level, and special certification in teaching the relevant handicap, plus a better-than-average performance evaluation score. At no time during the 1987-89 biennium shall the combined use of all titles referenced above exceed the grand total of the appropriation.

SECTION 9. The Superintendent of the Arkansas School for the Deaf and the Superintendent of the Arkansas School for the Blind shall, on or before July 1, 1988, consolidate and combine food services, purchasing, and such business office functions of the two institutions as may be consolidated and combined without hampering the separate programatic needs of the two institutions.

SECTION 10. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 11. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 12. CONTRACT RESTRICTIONS. The agency, board, commission, department or institution to whom funds are appropriated by this Act shall not enter into any contract for any professional or consultant services which shall extend for more than twenty (20) actual working days or the total compensation exceeds five thousand dollars (\$5,000) during any one fiscal year without first seeking the advice of the Arkansas Legislative Council. Provided further, that all contracts for professional or consultant services shall be submitted monthly to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State for reporting to the Legislative Council.

SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Sixth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1987 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1987 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1987.
