Act 462 HB1595

"AN ACT TO REQUIRE STATE AGENCIES TO IMPLEMENT A SMOKING POLICY FOR THEIR GENERAL OFFICE SPACE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

- SECTION 1. For the purposes of this Act:
- (a) "State agency" means any department, agency, board, commission, office or other authority of the State.
- (b) "Smoking" means a lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe or any other lit tobacco product.
- (C) "General office space" means space occupied by personnel performing their daily work functions.
- SECTION 2. The chief administrative officer of each State agency shall promulgate a smoking policy for the general office space of the State agency. The policy shall take into consideration the rights of both non-smokers and smokers. The smoking policy for each State agency shall be implemented by September 1, 1987.
- SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
