Act 538 HB1800

"AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 1505 OF ACT 280 OF 1975 [ARK. STAT. 41-1505], RELATING TO NEGLIGENT HOMICIDE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 1505 of Act 280 of 1975, the same being Arkansas Statute 41-1505, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1505. NEGLIGENT HOMICIDE.

- (1)(a) A person commits negligent homicide if he negligently causes the death of another person, not constituting murder or manslaughter, as a result of operating a vehicle, an aircraft, or watercraft;
 - (i) while intoxicated; or
- (ii) if at that time there is 0.10% or more by weight of alcohol in the person's blood as determined by a chemical test of the person's blood, urine, breath, or other bodily substance.
- (b) A person who violates subsection (1) is guilty of a class $\ensuremath{\mathsf{D}}$ felony.
- (2) (a) A person commits negligent homicide if he negligently causes the death of another person.
- (b) A person who violates subsection (2) is guilty of a class A misdemeanor.
- (3) For the purpose of this Section 'Intoxicated' means influenced or affected by the ingestion of alcohol, a controlled substance, any intoxicant, or any combination thereof, to such a degree that the driver's reactions, motor skills, and judgment are substantially altered and the driver, therefore, constitutes a clear and substantial danger of physical injury or death to himself and other motorists or pedestrians."
- SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
