Act 11 HB1001

"AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE ARKANSAS HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES FOR THE FOURTH EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF THE SEVENTY SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Sixth General Assembly, meeting in Fourth Extraordinary Session, that the appropriation for the Arkansas House of Representatives as provided by Act 1 of 1987, Act 18 of 1987 First Extraordinary Session, Act 1 of 1987 Second Extraordinary Session, and Act 2 of 1988 Third Extraordinary Session did not anticipate the convening by the Governor of another extraordinary session and that additional appropriation must be provided to defray such additional costs as may be incurred. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and its passage and approval.
