"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 7-5-522(d) RELATING TO THE PERIOD OF TIME A VOTER MAY REMAIN IN A VOTING BOOTH."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 7-5-522 (d) is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(d) No voter shall remain in the voting booth longer than five (5) minutes, if voters are waiting in line. If voters are waiting in line, it shall be the duty of the judges to require the voter to leave the voting booth after five (5) minutes have elapsed. If any voter fails to leave the booth after having been notified that five (5) minutes have elapsed, the judges shall cause him to be removed by police, peace officer, or bailiff if necessary."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
