"AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT IF A CHANGE OF VENUE IS TAKEN FROM A CITY COURT, MAYOR'S COURT OR POLICE COURT TO A MUNICIPAL COURT, ALL FEES COLLECTED SHALL BE TRANSFERRED TO THE CITY COURT, MAYOR'S COURT OR POLICE COURT IN WHICH THE CASE ORIGINATED; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. In the event of any change of venue from a city court, mayor's court or police court to a municipal court located in the same county, all fines collected in that case shall be transferred to the city court, mayor's court or police court in which the case originated.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
