"AN ACT TO SET THE SALARY RANGES FOR THE JUDGE AND CLERK OF THE MAUMELLE MUNICIPAL COURT."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The Maumelle Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) nor more than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000). The municipal court clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than twelve thousand six hundred fifty dollars (\$12,650) nor more than twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000). The salary shall be as determined by the Board of Directors of the City of Maumelle.

SECTION 2. Subsection (jjj) of Arkansas Code 16-17-108 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly that the preservation of justice requires that certain salaries be affixed by law; that it is necessary for the continuation of administration of justice that this act take effect immediately. Therefore, this act being necessary for the preservation of the public health, welfare, and safety shall become effective immediately upon passage.
