"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 27-22-103 TO PROVIDE THAT ANYONE OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE IN THIS STATE WITHOUT MINIMUM LIABILITY COVERAGE SHALL BE FINED NOT LESS THAN FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00) NOR MORE THAN TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$250.00) AND THE PERSON'S DRIVING PRIVILEGES SHALL BE SUSPENDED FOR ONE YEAR; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-22-103 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"27-22-103. Penalty. (a) Any person who operates a motor vehicle within this state in violation of this chapter shall be fined not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor more than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00), the minimum fine shall be mandatory.

(b) Any person who fails to carry proof of insurance coverage in his motor vehicle glove pocket shall be fined not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor more than two hundred fifty (\$250.00).

SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
