"AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DIVISION OF VITAL RECORDS OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO COLLECT SOCIAL SECURITY INFORMATION OF PARENTS AT THE TIME OF BIRTH OF A CHILD IN THIS STATE; TO PERMIT THE DISCLOSURE OF SUCH INFORMATION TO THE CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT UNIT UPON REQUEST; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. (a) Social security account information of parents of a child born within this state shall be furnished to the Division of Vital Records at the time of filing the certificate of birth but such information shall not appear on the certificate.

(b) The Division of Vital Records shall make available the records of parent name and social security number to the Child Support Enforcement Unit for its use in the establishment of paternity or the enforcement of child support orders through electronic transfer mechanism. Such disclosure shall constitute an exception to the prohibitions within Ark. Code 20-18-304.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective on November 25, 1990.

SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
