"AN ACT TO REQUIRE COURT REPORTERS TO TRANSCRIBE CIRCUIT COURT PROCEEDINGS AND FORWARD THEM TO THE CIRCUIT CLERKS AT LEAST TWENTY DAYS PRIOR TO THE TIME THEY ARE DUE ON CASES APPEALED; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. In all cases before the circuit courts of this State, a complete record of the proceedings shall be made by the official court reporter, or other reporter designated by the court, and upon the request of either party, or the circuit judge, said record shall be transcribed, certified by the reporter as true and correct, and filed with the clerk of the court in which the proceedings were had, not less than ten days before the expiration of time allowed for appeal.

SECTION 2. Nothing contained in this act shall prevent the parties with the permission of the circuit court from waiving a complete record of the proceeding.

SECTION 3. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
