"AN ACT TO CREATE A TEMPORARY COMMISSION TO STUDY A PROPOSAL TO REQUIRE THE OIL AND GAS COMMISSION TO PROVIDE GAS PRODUCTION RECORDS TO EACH COUNTY ASSESSOR; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

- SECTION 1. (a) There is hereby created a commission to study the proposal of requiring the Arkansas Oil and Gas Commission to provide to each county assessor, no later than January 1 and July 1 of each year, a record of natural gas production within the county for the previous six (6) months. The record shall indicate the well name, the legal description of the well location, and the name and mailing address of the operator of the well.
 - (b) The membership of the commission shall be as follows:
- (1) One member shall be the Director of the Assessment Coordination $\operatorname{Division}$;
 - (2) One member shall be the Director of the Oil and Gas Commission;
- (3) Three members shall be from the Oil and Gas Commission to be appointed by the Governor; and
- (4) Four members shall be county assessors from oil and/or gas producing counties to be appointed by the Governor, with two county assessors from northern Arkansas and two county assessors from southern Arkansas.
 - (c) This commission shall terminate on December 31, 1991.
- SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
- SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this \mbox{Act} are hereby repealed.
