"AN ACT TO CREATE A DRUG FREE PARK ZONE; TO PRESCRIBE
ADDITIONAL PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS WITHIN THE ZONE; AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Any person who commits an offense under Ark. Code 5-64-401(a) by selling, delivering, dispensing, transporting, administering or distributing a controlled substance within one thousand (1,000) feet of the real property of a city or state park shall have any term of imprisonment imposed for the violation of Section 5-64-401(a) enhanced by a term of ten (10) years and a fine of not less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000). The enhanced portion of the sentence shall be consecutive to any other sentence imposed. Any person convicted under this section shall not be eligible for early release on parole for the enhanced portion of the sentence.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
