Arkansas Code 10-3-802(b) is hereby amended to read as 15 follows: 16 "(b) The committee shall be a select committee of the House and Senate, 17 whose members shall be chosen as follows: (1) Five (5) members of the Senate to be named by the Senate Committee 18 19 on Committees; and 20 (2) Nine (9) members of the House of Representatives to be named by the 21 Speaker of the House. The Speaker shall also name one alternate member for 22 each of the nine (9) House members. Members and alternate members of the 23 Joint Committee on Energy shall be appointed at each regular biennial session 24 of the General Assembly and shall serve until the convening of the next 25 regular session of the General Assembly." 26 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 27 28 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 29 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 30 31 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 32 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 33 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 34 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 35 act are declared to be severable. 36

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General 5 Assembly that it is immediately necessary to provide for the appointment of 6 alternate members of the Joint Committee on Energy and that until this Act 7 becomes effective such appointments cannot be made. Therefore, an emergency 8 is hereby declared to exist and this Act being immediately necessary for the 9 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and 10 effect from and after its passage and approval. /s/John Paul Capps APPROVED: 2-1-91
