The responsibility for transportation for a student from his 16 resident school district to a nonresident school district shall be borne, 17 generally, by the student. The resident district may transport the student to 18 the district boundary or to a point agreeable to the parent or the nonresident 19 district within either the resident or nonresident district and count that 20 student in the resident district's calculation for transportation funding. 21 The nonresident district may provide transportation from the resident 22 district's boundary or from a point agreeable with the parent or the resident 23 district within either the resident or nonresident district to a school in the 24 nonresident district and count that student in the nonresident district's 25 calculation for transportation funding. 26 27 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 28 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 29 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 30 31 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 32 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 33 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 34 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 35 act are declared to be severable. 36

1 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are 2 hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the 5 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly that confusion exists as to who bears the 6 responsibility of transporting students from their resident school districts 7 to nonresident school districts; that this act is necessary to clear up any 8 confusion; and that this act should be effective immediately. Therefore, an 9 emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act being necessary for the 10 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full 11 force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
