Wood, Stephens and Dowd 6 7 For An Act To Be Entitled g "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF COMMUNITY BASED 9 EDUCATION CENTERS TO EXPAND THE OPERATION OF EXISTING 10 11 SECONDARY VOCATIONAL SERVICE CENTERS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES." 12 13 14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS: 15 SECTION 1. Community Based Education Centers. The State Board of Vocational Education shall establish criteria 17 18 that must be met by any secondary vocational center requesting permission to 19 become a community based education center. The board shall periodically 20 review and revise, if necessary, this community based education center 21 criteria. Such centers may include offerings of traditional vocational 22 education during regular school hours, extended day programs so that students 23 may attend the center for vocational instruction after regular school hours, 24 ABE/GAE programs, adult skill training and/or retraining for the general 25 population, industry start-up and retraining, and workplace literacy. (b) Any secondary vocational center which satisfies the criteria 26 27 established by the board pursuant to this section may, in accordance with 28 procedures to be adopted by the board, seek approval from the board to become 29 a community based education center. Upon approval by the board of any such 30 application, the school may change its name to Community Based 31 Education Center. 32 State Board Policy. The State Board of Vocational 33 SECTION 2. 34 Education shall establish policy for community based education centers in such 35 areas as: fees, operating and capital budgets, allocation of funds,

36 instructional programs and related criteria for the operation of community

1 based education centers, degrees and certificates, academic and programmatic 2 standards. 3 SECTION 3. Application. Following publication by the State Board of 5 Vocational Education of criteria required to qualify for designation as a 6 community based education center, local educational agencies may develop a 7 budget proposal for submission to the State Board for funding consideration. 8 In-so-far as possible, the Board shall distribute the funds in as equitable a 9 manner as possible while maintaining the best utilization of funds as 10 appropriated by the General Assembly. 11 SECTION 4. Criteria. The State Board shall relate to the community 12 13 based education centers as a coordinating board. Furthermore, the governing 14 board of a community based education center is encouraged to create a general 15 advisory council. Such council shall provide advice on programs of the 16 school, including data that reflects the needs of business and industry served 17 by the community based education center. Upon request by the community based 18 education center, the State Council on Vocational Education shall provide such 19 assistance as may be required to establish a general advisory council. 20 SECTION 5. Service Board. The board which currently owns the property 22 and capital equipment of any existing community based education center is 23 authorized to retain ownership of such properties. Provided however, 24 ownership of such properties may, by vote of the board, be restructured. 25 Furthermore, the board of the host school is encouraged to create a board 26 composed of superintendents of all schools sending students to the community 27 based education center. Such board may act as a governing board for the 28 community based education center. Furthermore, such boards are encouraged to 29 have members that are representative of business and industry in the community 30 based education centers service area. 31 SECTION 6. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature 32 33 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code

34 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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SECTION 7. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to
 2 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
 3 other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without
 4 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
 5 Act are declared to be severable.
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         SECTION 8 . All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are
8 hereby repealed.
