For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT AND COMPENSATION OF

9 THE DIRECTOR OF THE ARKANSAS ARCHEOLOGICAL SURVEY; AND FOR

10 OTHER PURPOSES."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

- 14 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated 13-6-202 is hereby amended to read
- 15 as follows:
- 16 "13-6-202. Survey's functions. The Arkansas Archeological Survey shall
- 17 initiate, operate, and maintain a program in archeology which shall include,
- 18 but not be limited to, the following areas of action:
- 19 (1) Excavation of archeological and historical sites, ruins, and mounds
- 20 for the purpose of securing data and objects relating to early man in
- 21 Arkansas;
- 22 (2) Fundamental research in Arkansas archeology and encouragement of
- 23 public cooperation in the preservation of Arkansas antiquities;
- 24 (3) Research in and study of anthropology, soil, geology, and related
- 25 social and physical sciences, both prior to excavation and thereafter, in
- 26 order to plan and aid in discovery of sites and artifacts and their proper
- 27 assessment once discovered;
- 28 (4) Publication of findings in terms of their scientific, popular, and
- 29 cultural values;
- 30 (5) Display and custodianship of relics, artifacts, sites, and other
- 31 tangible results of the program;
- 32 (6) Educational activities providing a stimulus to archeological
- 33 efforts and the encouragement of archeological societies, parks, and museums."

- 35 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Annotated 13-6-203 is hereby amended to read
- 36 as follows:

"13-6-203. Director of Survey. (a) The President of the University of 2 Arkansas shall appoint a Director of the Arkansas Archeological Survey who 3 shall have a Doctor of Philosophy in Anthropology with a specialization in 4 Archeology or the equivalent in training and experience who shall be 5 responsible for the overall administration and coordination of the Survey, and 6 who shall serve at the pleasure of the president of the university. The director shall perform the duties that may be set by the 8 President of the University of Arkansas and may be paid from funds 9 appropriated for the Arkansas Archeological Survey." 10 11 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code Annotated 13-6-204 is hereby amended to read 12 as follows: "13-6-204. State Archeologist and other Survey personnel. 13 14 President of the University of Arkansas shall appoint a State Archeologist who 15 shall have a Doctor of Philosophy Degree in Anthropology with a specialization 16 in Archeology, or the equivalent in training and experience, and such other 17 full-time or part-time employees as may be required to carry on the program, 18 all of whom shall possess such qualifications as may be prescribed by the 19 President. The State Archeologist shall be a full-time employee of the 20 Survey. 21 (b) The personnel of the Arkansas Archeological Survey shall be deemed 22 employees of the University of Arkansas." 23 SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 2.4 25 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 26 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 27 SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 28 29 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 30 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 31 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this

32 act are declared to be severable.

34 SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are 35 hereby repealed.
