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For An Act To Be Entitled 7 "AN ACT TO AMEND THE PUBLIC FACILITIES BOARD ACT TO g PROVIDE THAT SUCH BOARDS ARE NOT ADMINISTRATIVE BOARDS 9 UNDER THE COUNTY GOVERNMENT CODE; TO GRANT SUCH BOARDS 10 EMINENT DOMAIN AUTHORITY; TO ELIMINATE THE PROHIBITION AGAINST THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SERVING AS A MEMBER OF A 12 PUBLIC FACILITIES BOARD; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES." 13 14 15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS: 16

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18 follows:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 14-137-106(a) is hereby amended to read as

- 19 Any municipality or any county is authorized to create one (1) or
- 20 more public facilities boards and to empower each board to own, acquire,
- 21 construct, reconstruct, extend, equip, improve, operate, maintain, sell,
- 22 lease, contract concerning, or otherwise deal in or dispose of health care
- 23 facilities, emergency medical health care facilities, residential housing
- 24 facilities, off-street parking facilities, recreational and tourist
- 25 facilities, waterworks facilities, sewer facilities, facilities for securing
- 26 or developing industry, energy facilities, hydroelectric power projects,
- 27 education facilities, other capital improvement facilities, or any combination
- 28 of such facilities, or any interest in such facilities including, without
- 29 limitation, leasehold interests in and mortgages on such facilities. Public
- 30 facilities boards created under this chapter are not administrative boards
- 31 under the County Government Code (Chapter 14 of Title 14 of the Arkansas
- 32 Code)."

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- SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 14-137-109 is hereby amended to read as 34
- 35 follows:
- 36 "14-137-109. Officers - Executive Director.

- 1 (a)(1) The members of each public facilities board shall meet and
- 2 organize by electing one of their number as chairman, one as vice-chairman,
- $\ensuremath{\mathtt{3}}$ one as secretary, and one as treasurer, and such officers shall be elected
- 4 annually thereafter in like manner.
- 5 (2) The duties of secretary and treasurer may be performed by the same 6 member.
- 7 (b) The board may also appoint an executive director who shall serve at
- 8 the pleasure of the board and receive such compensation as shall be fixed by
- 9 the board."

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- 11 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 14-137-112 is hereby amended by inserting an
- 12 additional subsection at the end thereof to read as follows:
- 13 "(c) Public facilities boards which operate water works facilities may
- 14 exercise the power of eminent domain in accordance with the procedures
- 15 prescribed by Arkansas Code 18-15-1201 et seq."

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- 17 SECTION 4. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature
- 18 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
- 19 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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- 21 SECTION 5. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to
- 22 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
- 23 other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without
- 24 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
- 25 Act are declared to be severable.

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- 27 SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are
- 28 hereby repealed.

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- 30 SECTION 7. Emergency. It is hereby found and determined by the General
- 31 Assembly that the changes this Act makes in the public facilities board law
- 32 will result in the more efficient and effective operation of those boards;
- 33 that the services provided by public facilities boards are in any many
- 34 instances vital to the public health and welfare; that the effect of this Act
- 35 will be to provide better services to the people served by public facilities

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1 boards; and that this Act should go into effect immediately in order to
 2 enhance the services of the public facilities boards as soon as possible.
 3 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
 4 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
 5 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and
 6 approval.
