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1 SECTION 4. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to 2 3 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 4 other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without 5 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 6 Act are declared to be severable. 7 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are 9 hereby repealed. 10 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY. It has been found and determined by the General 11 12 Assembly that present law provides for collection of delinquent suburban 13 improvement district taxes by inclusion of the suburban improvement taxes and 14 penalty in the county collector's tax sale for ad valorem real property taxes. Such sale has been abolished, leaving no clear remedy for delinquent suburban 16 improvement taxes.
