## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE RECIPROCITY TO STATES WHICH DO NOT REQUIRE NON-RESIDENT HUNTING AND FISHING LICENSES FOR SENIOR CITIZENS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS
```

SECTION 1. (a) Any non-resident, sixty-five (65) years of age or older, whose home state does not require non-resident fishing or hunting licenses for persons sixty-five (65) years of age and older, shall not be required to purchase a non-resident fishing or hunting license to lawfully hunt or fish in this state, provided, that person possesses a valid hunting or fishing license issued by their home state for the species of fish or game they are attempting to take.
(b) The Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission is authorized to enter into reciprocity agreements with other states and issue necessary rules and regulations for the implementation of this act.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
