## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE PROBATE CLERK FOR PULASKI COUNTY, ARKANSAS."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The Chancery and Probate Judges of Pulaski County, Arkansas, shall designate a Probate Clerk who shall serve as clerk in all probate matters and as custodian of all probate papers and records.

SECTION 2. It shall be the duty of the Pulaski County Probate Clerk and clerk's deputies to perform the work and services under the supervision of the Pulaski County Chancery and Probate Judges.

SECTION 3. The Pulaski County Probate Clerk shall collect all fees related to probate matters, as provided by law. The fees collected shall be paid into the Pulaski County General Fund and dispersed pursuant to law.

SECTION 4. The salaries of the Pulaski County Probate Clerk and clerk's deputies shall be paid as established by law.

SECTION 5. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 6. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.
