8	"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE §23-13-206(a)(1) TO REQUIRE
9	THAT CARRIERS OF CERTAIN EXEMPT COMMODITIES AND PASSENGERS
10	BE SUBJECT TO SAFETY OF OPERATION AND EQUIPMENT STANDARDS
11	PROVISIONS AS REQUIRED OF OTHER CARRIERS SO THAT ARKANSAS
12	LAWS ARE COMPATIBLE WITH FEDERAL MOTOR CARRIER SAFETY
13	REGULATIONS THUS INSURING THE CONTINUED RECEIPT OF FEDERAL

17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
18	
19	SECTION 1. Subdivision (a)(1) of Arkansas Code §23-13-206 is hereby
20	amended to read as follows:
21	"(1) Motor vehicles employed solely in transporting school children and
22	teachers to or from school and motor vehicles used in carrying set-up houses,
23	ordinary livestock, unprocessed fish including shellfish, unprocessed
24	agricultural commodities, baled cotton, cottonseed, cottonseed meal,
25	cottonseed hulls, cottonseed cake, rice hulls, rice bran, rice mill feed, rice
26	mill screenings, soybean meal, commercial fertilizer but not including the
27	component parts used in the manufacture thereof. However, carriers of such
28	exempt commodities and passengers shall be subject to safety of operation and
29	equipment standards provisions prescribed or hereafter prescribed by the
30	commission, additionally, for-hire carriers of such exempt commodities shall
31	file with the commission evidence of security for the protection of the public
32	in the same amount and to the same extent as nonexempt carriers as provided in
33	23-13-227;"

35 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 36 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code

1 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 4 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 5 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 6 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 7 act are declared to be severable. SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are 10 hereby repealed. APPROVED: 3-1-91
