(a) Upon the written request of the governing body of a 16 suburban improvement district, a county may by ordinance regulate the discharge of firearms and the shooting of archery equipment within all or any 18 part of the suburban improvement district. (b) As used in this section "Suburban Improvement District" means a 19 20 suburban improvement district governed by Arkansas Code 14-92-201, et seq. or 21 its predecessor Acts. 22 Upon the written request of a property owners association 2.3 SECTION 2. 24 which has a population at least equal to that prescribed for cities of the 25 first class and which is located outside the boundaries of a municipality, a 26 county may by ordinance regulate the discharge of firearms and the shooting of 27 archery equipment within all or any part of the area included in the property 28 owners association. 29 30 SECTION 3. Nothing in this act shall be construed to prohibit: 31 (1) The discharge of a firearm or archery equipment in the defense of 32 life or property; 33 The discharge of a firearm or archery equipment at a public or 34 private shooting range or gallery; or (3) The discharge of a firearm by a law enforcement officer in the 35 36 performance of his or her duty.

SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
 2 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
 3 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

         SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
 6 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
 7 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
 8 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
 9 act are declared to be severable.

         SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
