## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT ANY FREIGHT OR PARCEL DELIVERY SERVICE SHALL PAY INTEREST ON ANY DEPOSIT THEY REQUIRE BEFORE FURNISHING DELIVERY SERVICE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Whenever any person, company, or corporation furnishing customers with freight or parcel delivery service shall require a deposit from the customer before the delivery service will be supplied to him the person putting up the deposit shall receive interest annually on the deposit until it is returned to the customer, provided all bills due for services furnished have been paid by the customer.

SECTION 2. The annual rate of interest shall be ten percent (10\%) per year and shall be paid on or before December 31 of each year.

SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
