## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 7-5-415 TO INCREASE THE COMPENSATION OF THE COUNTY CLERK FOR AN EXTRA DEPUTY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
```

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 7-5-415 is amended to read as follows:
"7-5-415. Compensation of clerk for extra deputy.
The county clerk shall be paid not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) nor more than forty dollars (\$40.00) per day, not to exceed twenty (20) days, for an extra deputy hired for the purpose of carrying out the requirements of this act. The fee shall be established and paid by the county, city, or other political subdivision, the representatives of which call the election, or in the case of a primary, by the party conducting the primary. In the regular general election, the fee shall be established and paid by the county."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws or parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
