8	"AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF
9	EDUCATION - GENERAL EDUCATION DIVISION FOR THE PAYMENT OF
10	PER DIEM AND ACTUAL NECESSARY EXPENSES OF NON-STATE
11	EMPLOYEES WHO ARE MEMBERS OF THE EDUCATION LAWS REVISION
12	COMMISSION FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993;
13	AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
16	
17	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the
18	Department of Education - General Education Division, to be payable from the
19	Department of Education Fund Account, for the payment of per diem and actual
20	necessary expenses of non-state employees who are members of the Education
21	Laws Revision Commission for the biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the sum
22	of\$3,480.
23	
24	SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
25	authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
26	and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
27	the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
28	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
29	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
30	laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
31	Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
32	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.
33	
34	SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
35	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
36	contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which

1 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 2 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 3 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 4 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 5 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 6 7 SECTION 4. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent 8 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas 9 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 10 11 SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the 12 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such 13 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which 14 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this 15 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable. 16 SECTION 6. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict 17 18 with this Act are hereby repealed. 19 20 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the 21 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of 22 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year 23 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the 24 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, 25 and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the 26 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm 27 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 28 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 29 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 30 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991. 31 32 APPROVED: 3-13-91 33 34 35
